

Growzer Privacy Policy

Growzer NV values your privacy. Although most of the information on this site is available without the need to provide personal information, it is possible that the user personal information may be requested. This information will only be used in the context of customer management and informing you of news and information concerning Growzer NV. The user can, free of charge and on request, always oppose the use of his/her data for direct marketing. To do so, he will contact Growzer NV at info@growzer.be. Your personal data will never be passed on to third parties.

In accordance with the law on processing personal data of 08/12/1992, the user has a right to inspect and, if necessary, correct personal data. Subject to proof of identity (copy of identity card) you can, via a written, dated and signed request to Growzer NV, info@growzer.be to obtain the written communication of your personal data. If necessary, you can also ask to correct the data that are incorrect, incomplete or irrelevant. Growzer NV may collect anonymous or aggregated data of a non-personal nature, such as browser type or IP address, the operating programme you use or the domain name of the website through which you arrived at the Growzer website, or through which you leave it. This allows us to permanently optimise the Growzer website for the users.

Use of "cookies".

During a visit to the site, 'cookies' may be placed on the hard drive of your computer for the sole purpose of making the site more responsive to the needs of returning visitors. These mini files or cookies are not used to track the visitor's surfing behaviour on other websites. Your internet browser allows you to prevent the use of cookies, to receive a warning when a cookie is installed or to remove the cookies from your hard disk afterwards. Google analytics
